The ONU Polar Card is the Ohio Northern University student's pass to campus-wide privileges. The Polar Card is an electronically readable, multiple use photo ID, originally issued free of charge. It is the official means of identification for students and gives access to a wide variety of facilities, activities and services, including:

- Performing Arts Center**
- Sports Center**
- Heterick Library**
- Law Library**
- Health Center**
- Food Service**
- Residence Halls**
- ONU Sports Events**

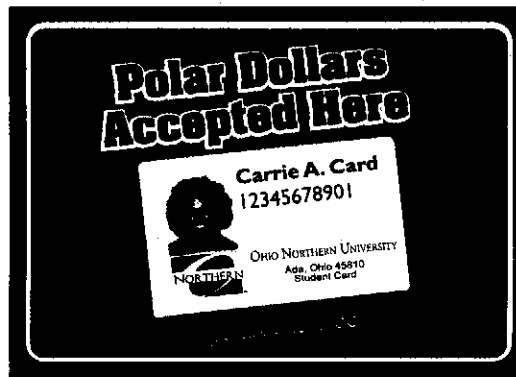
POLAR DOLLARS

The Polar Card also comes with debit card capability - Polar Dollars. Polar Dollars are accepted for purchases on-campus and, **new this year, at participating off-campus merchants as well!**

Students may deposit any amount (\$25 minimum) onto their Polar Card for both on and off-campus purchases. Polar Dollars functions as a declining debit account, so there is no risk of overdrawing the account, or of accumulating credit debt. Additionally, a student can only spend funds that are available, so no overdraft fees will ever be assessed.

With no fees and no interest, Polar Dollars is a great budgeting tool.

How to deposit:

Balances carry over from quarter to quarter and from year to year. Balances on the Polar Card can be refunded at the end of the school year, or upon withdrawal or graduation from the university.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The Polar Card is the property of the Ohio Northern University and has been issued only for the student's use. The Polar Card is non-transferable. Lending the Polar Card to anyone or possessing another person's Polar Card is a violation of University regulations and will result in confiscation of the card. The University is not responsible for any loss, theft or misuse of the card. It is the student's responsibility and should be carried at all times.

*A lost or stolen card should be reported immediately by phone or in person to one of the following: Controller's Office - 419.772.2010 or 419.772.2687, Monday to Friday 8 AM to 5 PM
After hours: Security - 419.772.2222, Dining Services - 419.772.2414*

Upon report, the card will be deactivated immediately. The Card can be replaced between the hours of 8 AM to 5 PM Monday through Friday at the Controller's Office. A fee is charged for a replacement card. Once the replacement card is issued, the previous card becomes invalid. Polar Dollars are only accessible until a replacement card is issued and the account reactivated.
