The event is free and open to the public.

The purchasing office and physical plant will work together to schedule pickups. Pickup requests submitted after Dec. 15 will be filed and saved until the next auction is scheduled.

Proceeds from the auction, less auction expenses, are allocated to the departments' equipment accounts. Auction expenses will be divided among the submitting departments in proportion to the percentage of the total dollar amount sold.
