Women's Swimming & Diving

Record: 5-4 Overall, 3-0 OAC (t1st) - OAC Regular Season Champions

Last Week: Won 150-148 at Oberlin, Fri.; Won 122-82 at Notre Dame (Ohio.), Sat.; Won 156-87 at Mount Union, Sat.

This Week: H v Case Western Reserve, Fri.; at Baldwin-Wallace, Sat.

Notes:

- The Ohio Northern women's swimming and diving team (5-4 overall, 3-0 OAC) clinched a share of its third consecutive OAC Regular Season title with a 156-87 victory over Mount Union on Sat.
- The Polar Bears would win the title outright with a victory at Baldwin-Wallace Sat. in their regular season finale.
- Northern won the OAC regular season title last year with a perfect 4-0 mark and shared the 2006 regular season crown with a 3-1 record.
- The Polar Bears also won the 2007 OAC Championships meet.
- ONU won three dual meets on the road at three different schools in a 24-hour span over the weekend, winning at Oberlin 150-148 on Fri. night, winning at Notre Dame (Ohio) 122-

- The Ohio Northern women's basketball team (11-3 overall, 6-1 OAC) solidified its spot as a OAC title contender by sweeping a pair of nationally-ranked foes last week.
- The Polar Bears entered the week in a four-way tie for first place and remained atop the OAC with a convincing 66-51 victory over #23 Wilmington Wed. and a 51-48 victory over #24 Capital on Sat.
- The Polar Bears are tied atop the OAC with Baldwin-Wallace.
- The win over Wilmington broke a 17-game losing streak to the Quakers and extended the Polar Bears home win-streak to 12 games.
- Senior **Jenny Markle (Copley)**, the nation's leading three-point shooter at 59.7 percent (49-of-77), became ONU's career-leader in three-

- Sophomore **Jillian Huber (Glandorf/Ottawa-Glandorf)** led the Polar Bears with two victories against Mount Union and another against Notre Dame.

- Against MUC, she won the 1000 free in 11:51.08 and won the 100 free in :57.97. She won the 100 back in 1:07.03 at NDC.

- Sophomore **Kim Randall (Milford)** and freshman **Hannah Bukowy (Notre Canton/Hoover)** each won one event in each of the three meets.

- Randall won the 200 free in 2:03.05 at MUC, won the 500 free in 5:33.81 at NCD and won the 200 free in 2:03.58 at Oberlin.

- Bukowy won the 100 breast in all three meets, winning in 1:11.91 at MUC, in 1:11.88 at NDC and 1:10.99 at Oberlin.

- ONU will wrap up its regular season this weekend with a home dual with Case Western Reserve on Fri. and at Baldwin-Wallace on Sat. - Friday night's dual is also the team's annual Cystic Fibrosis fundraiser. As always, all of the money raised during the meet will go directly to the Cystic Fibrosis Fund.

- The Ohio Northern men's basketball team (9-5 overall, 5-2 OAC) split a pair of OAC games last week, winning 66-62 at Wilmington Wed. and falling 69-67 to #16 Capital at home on Sat.
- Junior **Jake Cannan (Dublin/Coffman)** and sophomore Kyle Meyer (Columbus Grove) led ONU past Wilmington.
- Cannan scored a game-high 19 points and Meyer recorded his first career double-double with 14 points and a career-high 10 rebounds.
- Freshman **Sam Bastian (Toledo/Central Catholic)** tied his career-high with 13 points against the Quakers.
- Meyer also added 13 points against Capital.

Polar Bears split pair of close games, win at Wilmington, fall to #16 Capital

- Cannan is second in scoring at 11.6 ppg and leads ONU in rebounding (8.0 rpg) and blocked shots (19).
- Cannan ranks ninth all-time at ONU with 43 career blocked shots.
- Meyer is currently third on the team in scoring at 10.0 ppg and is second in rebounding at 5.3 rpg.
- Senior **Kyle Gehle (Versailles)** had a game-high 23 points in the loss to Capital.
- Gehle now ranks 29th all-time at ONU in scoring with 1,081 career points.
- This season, Gehle leads ONU in scoring at 17.6 ppg and is fourth in rebounding at 4.2 rpg.
- The Polar Bears will return to action Wed. at Ohio Athletic Conference foe Muskingum and will travel to Mount Union on Sat.

Notes:

- The Ohio Northern men's indoor track and field team (2-0 overall) won the season-opening Friday Night Series meet, scoring 339 points.
- Junior **Jimmy O'Brien (Pemberville/Eastwood)** shattered the ONU-record in the 1,000-meter run and senior **Ryan Robertson (Pickerington/Central)** won three events to lead the men's team.
- O'Brien took the lead from the gun in the 1,000 and won a time of 2:30.79, breaking Mark Bierkan's mark of 2:32.28 set in 2006. He also capped the meet by anchoring the 4x400 relay to victory in 3:31.40.
- Robertson won the long jump with a leap of 22-03.75 and won the 55-meter dash in 6.48, just .01 of a second away from the NCAA provisional mark. He also teamed with junior **Justin Linzy (Toledo/Woodward)** and freshmen **Ryan Fleming (Maitland Fla./Lyman)** and **Julian Horn (DeWitt, Mich.)** to win the 4x200 relay in 1:31.82.

- Freshman **Jacob Fox (Rockford/Parkway)** nearly qualified for the NCCC Championships in his first collegiate meet by running a 7.78 in his preliminary heat of the 55-meter hurdles. He later clocked a time of 7.84 to win the event in the finals and finished third in the long jump with a leap of 21-05.5.
- Junior **Paul Lewis (Medina)** won the 1-mile run in 4:32.08.
- Freshman **Shane Huntley (Sandusky/Perkins)** won the 300-meter dash in 37.14, while sophomore **Joe Amstutz (Bluffton)** used a stirring kick to win the 400-meter dash in :51.78, in addition to his leg in the victorious 4x400-meter relay team.
- In the field events, sophomore **Jacob Weyruach (Orrville)** won the pole vault with a height of 14-9.5 and freshman **Timothy Polack (Medina)** won the high jump with a leap of 5-6.
