Notes:
 - The Ohio Northern wrestling team (8-8 overall, 3-1 OAC) defeated Baldwin-Wallace 24-9 on Tue. to move into second place in the OAC regular season standings.
 - The Polar Bears also posted a 3-1 record at the Wabash (Ind.) Classic on Sat., defeating Millikin (Ill.) 57-0, Wabash (Ind.) 37-10 and Tri-State (Ind.) 42-3, while falling to NCAA Division II foe Indianapolis (Ind.) 24-18.
 - Freshman **Nick Hoopes (Beloit/West Branch)** led the Polar Bears with a perfect 6-0 record at 141 pounds, which includes an 11-2 major decision over Eric Schubert of BW.
 - Hoopes improves to 9-9 overall and is 3-1 in

 - Freshmen **Jeff Sommers (Clinton Township, Mich./Chippewa Valley)** and **Luke Miller (Indiana, Pa./Indiana Area)** each went 4-1 on the week with OAC victories in the BW dual.
 - Sommers is now 6-13 on the year, while Miller improves to 23-9.
 - No. 8-ranked junior **David Penny (Union/Milton-Union)** and freshman **Jason VanAtta (McComb)** each went 3-0 at 125 pounds.
 - Penny is 21-3 overall and 2-0 in OAC duals, while VanAtta improves to 6-5, 1-1.
 - The Polar Bears will return to OAC action Tue. at Mt. Union at 7:30 pm.

 - The Ohio Northern men's basketball team (10-7 overall, 6-4 OAC) stopped its three-game losing streak with an 80-65 win at Marietta Sat.
 - Sophomore **Kyle Meyer (Columbus Grove)** scored a game-high 17 points on 7-of-10 from the field and also pulled down seven rebounds. Meyer scored a career-high 24 points on 12-of-12 from the floor on Dec. 1 against the Pioneers in Ada.
 - Junior **Jake Cannan (Dublin/Coffman)** was also 7-for-10 shooting and finished with 15 points and eight rebounds for ONU.
 - Senior **Kyle Gehle (Versailles)** added 12 points and junior **Loudan Hammersmith (Bowling Green)** chipped in with 11.
 - With the game tied at 10-10, junior **Kurtis Brown (Continental)** knocked down a 3-point-er to ignite a 15-4 Polar Bear run to grab a

Meyer leads ONU to 80-65 road win at Marietta

25-14 lead with 9:55 to go in the first half.
 - The Bears scored 12 of the last 15 points in the half to take a 45-24 lead into the break.
 - ONU shot 49.2 percent (31-of-63) from the floor and 50 percent (8-of-16) from beyond the arc. The Pioneers were 38.7 percent (24-of-62) from the field and just 31.6 percent (6-of-19) from the 3-point line.
 - The Polar Bears were dominating around the basket, outscoring the Pioneers 42-28 in the paint and holding a 41-33 advantage on the boards.
 - This season, Gehle leads ONU in scoring (16.2 ppg), Cannan is second in scoring (12.2 ppg) and is tops in rebounding (8.5 rpg) and Meyer is third in scoring (10.9) and second in rebounding (5.2 rpg).
 - Northern will return to action this Wed. as it hosts Heidelberg at 7:30 pm in the ONU Sports Center.

Notes:

- The Ohio Northern women's basketball team (14-3 overall, 9-1 OAC) extended its home win-streak to 15 games with an 82-64 victory over Marietta on Sat.

- The win keeps the Polar Bears alone atop the OAC, one game clear of Baldwin-Wallace.

- Junior **Alisha Rinehart (Lima/Perry)** scored 20 points and dished out a career-high seven assists in the win. She also had two steals and a block while committing no turnovers in 27 minutes off the bench.

- Sophomore **Briattany Bogart (Northwood)** scored a career-high 11 points and snagged a season-high seven rebounds. She was 5-of-6 shooting from the floor.

Ohio Northern runs home win streak to 15 with 82-64 victory over Marietta

- Senior **Erin Brand (Yorkshire/Marion Local)**, battling the flu, scored 16 points and grabbed four rebounds in just 16 minutes. She has now scored 971 career points and is seventh all-time in ONU history.

- Fellow senior **Jenny Markle (Copley)**, ONU's all-time three-point leader, was a perfect 2-for-2 from beyond the arc and finished with 12 points against the Pios. She leads the nation in 3-point percentage at 57.8 percent (48-of-83) for the year.

- Northern forced 20 Marietta turnover to just eight of its own and held a 33-9 advantage in points off turnovers.

- The Polar Bears will travel to Heidelberg Wednesday night before returning home to host #23 Baldwin-Wallace in a key OAC matchup Saturday at 3 pm in the ONU Sports Center.

Notes:

- The Ohio Northern men's indoor track and field team (8-4 overall) finished fourth at the Midwest Invitational hosted by Monmouth (Ill.) Saturday afternoon.

- Augustana (Ill.) won the event with a 158.5 points while Wartburg (Iowa) and Monmouth tied for second with 135 points. ONU finished with 115.5 team points.

- Senior All-American **Ryan Robertson (Pickerington/Central)** won the long jump with a leap of 22' 8 1/2" (6.92m) and was second in the 55-meter dash at 6.51.

- Junior 800-meter National Champion **Jimmy O'Brien (Pemberville/Eastwood)** was the only other ONU winner as he took first in the 1-mile run in a time of 4:19.81.

- Fellow junior **Justin Linzy (Toledo/Woodward)** (4th) and freshman **Julian Horn (Dewitt, Mich.)** (5th) finished close behind Robertson in the 55-meter dash in 6.65 and 6.69, respectively. Horn also finished third

in the 200-meter run at 22.89.

- In the 400-meter dash, freshman **Jeff Messmer (Canal Winchester)** ran on ONU season-best 51.23 to finish third. He also finished fifth in the 55-hurdles in a time of 8.44.

- Sophomore **Joe Amstutz (Bluffton)** led three Polar Bear placers in the 800-meter run in 1:59.87 to finish third. **Steve Darmon (Brimfield/Field)** finished sixth in 2:02.36 and **Brad Neumann (Brunswick)** took eighth in 2:03.79.

- Junior **Thomas Adam (Cuyahoga Falls/ Walsh Jesuit)** and sophomore **Alan Bowsher (Bowling Green)** finished fourth and fifth in the 3,000-meter run. Adam crossed the line in 8:58.36 with Bowsher close behind at 8:59.74.

- In the pole vault, sophomore **Jacob Weyrauch (Orrville)** finished fourth with a career-best vault of 14' 11" (4.55m). Freshman **Andy Lambers (Tipp City/Tippecanoe)** tied for sixth at 13' 11 1/4" (4.25m).

- The Ohio Northern men's track and field team returns home to host the OAC Relays Friday night at 5 pm in the ONU Sports Center.

- Northern won its first-ever OAC Championships title last year and hopes to make it back-to-back titles this season.
- The Polar Bears won the 2008 OAC Regular Season title with a 4-0 record.
- Four ONU sophomores return after winning OAC championships as freshmen a year ago.
- **Lacey Shumate (Bucyrus/Colonel Crawford)** won six events and was named the OAC Women's Swimmer of the Year last winter.
- Despite missing a great deal of the 2007-08 season with an injury, she hopes to be back in form to defend her crowns and better her school records in the 200 back, 200 I.M. and 400 I.M. from last year.

- He is a 7-time OAC Champion and an 11-time All-OAC performer.
- Anderson, Kuhn and senior **John Miller (Lebanon)** were key returnees as ONU looks to defend all five of the OAC Championship relay titles from a year ago.
- Miller has been a part of seven OAC Championship relay teams and is a 9-time All-OAC performer.
- Freshmen **Michael Schultz (New Berlin, Wis./Martin Luther)** and **George Chesney (North Olmsted)** are both looking for big things in their first-ever OAC Championships.
- Schultz was named the OAC Swimmer of the Week on Jan. 14 and has set ONU records in the 200 free, 500 free, 1000 free, 1650 free and the 200 back this season.
- Chesney has surpassed the NCAA "B" cut multiple times in both the 1- and 3-meter diving and will likely qualify for the NCAA Championships March 20-22 at Oxford, Ohio.

- **Terri Lynn Shigle (Irwin, Pa./Penn-Trafford)** won the 1-meter diving competition last year and was named the OAC Swimmer of the Week on Jan. 21.
- Sophomore **Kim Randall (Milford)** was also part of two OAC championship relay teams and was named the OAC Swimmer of the Week on Jan. 14.
- Freshman **Hannah Bukowy (North Canton/Hoover)** hopes to make a big splash in her first OAC Championships. She will enter with fine credentials after being named the OAC Swimmer of the Week on Dec. 3.
