### Wrestling

**Record:** 11-8 Overall, 5-1 OAC (2nd)  
**Last Week:** 3rd of 7 with 48.5 points at OAC Championships at John Carroll, Sat.  
**This Week:** Idle.  
**Notes:**  
 - The Ohio Northern wrestling team (11-8 overall, 5-1 OAC) finished third out of seven teams with 48.5 points at the 2008 Ohio Athletic Conference Wrestling Championships Sat. at John Carroll  
 - Senior **Ben Plowman (Maumee)** went 2-0 and earned his third consecutive conference championship to lead the Polar Bears.  
 - Plowman entered as the top seed at 174 pounds and left a champion. He earned a 8-0 major decision over fifth-seeded Chris Farrington after a first round bye to earn a spot in the championship match.  
 - He then beat third-seeded Steven Bagnowski 4-2 for the championship.  
 - With the OAC title, Plowman (20-7) advances to the NCAA III Championships March 7-8 at Cedar Rapids, Iowa.  
 - Plowman won the 174-pound title as a junior last year and the 184-pound crown as a sophomore in 2006.  
 - He is one of just six ONU wrestlers to win three OAC titles in his career.  
 - This will mark his third consecutive trip to the

### Plowman, Penny lead ONU to 3rd place finish at OACs

NCAA Championships.  
 - Junior and No. 7-ranked **David Penny (West Milton/Milton-Union)** finished second at 125 pounds, earning All-Conference honors, going 2-1 on the day.  
 - Penny (27-7) received the league's lone at-large bid to the NCAA Championships and will join Plowman for the second consecutive year.  
 - Freshman **Luke Miller (Indiana, Pa./Indiana Area)** also had a second-place finish to earn All-OAC honors, going 2-1 at 157 pounds.  
 - Miller ended his rookie season with an ONU freshman-record 33 victories against only 11 losses.  
 - Sophomore **Jeff Penny (West Milton/Milton-Union)** earned a major decision and a 2-1 record at 133 pounds to finish third.  
 - He ends his season with a 14-18 record.  
 - Freshman **Jeff Sommers (Clinton Township, Mich./Chippewa Valley)** earned a 10-1 major decision over Mark Sedziol and a 3-0 decision over Rayshawn Eatmon to finish fourth at 149 pounds with a 2-2 record.  
 - He was 12-18 on the season.  
 - Ohio Northern finished third with 48.5 points. Heidelberg won with 99.5 points and John Carroll came in second with 88.5 points.

 - ONU is the No. 4 seed in this week's OAC Tournament and will host fifth-seeded Muskingum in a quarterfinal contest on Wed.  
 - The semifinals are slated for Fri. at the highest remaining seed and the finals are Sat. at the semifinal site.  
 - On Sat. against Mt. Union, junior **Kurtis Brown (Continental)** made a pair of free

 - Cannan, sophomore **Ezra Bradshaw (Cincinnati/Princeton)** and freshman **Sam Bastian (Toledo/Central Catholic)** each scored 11.  
 - Cannan finished with a game-high eight rebounds, while Bradshaw tied a career-high with six assists.

- The Ohio Northern women's basketball team (19-6 overall, 14-4 OAC) won a pair of OAC games to end the regular season last week.
- The Polar Bears won at Muskingum 86-66 on Wed. and then won at Mount Union 69-58 on Sat.
- Northern finished the regular season with a 19-6 overall record and a 14-4 mark in the OAC. The Polar Bears will be the No. 2-seed in the OAC Tournament and will host Mount Union on Tue. at 7:30 pm.
- With a win, ONU will host an OAC semifinal contest on Thursday at 7:30 pm. The finals are Sat. at 3 pm at the highest remaining seed.
- Senior forward **Erin Brand (Yorkshire/Marion Local)** scored a season-high 25 points and grabbed four rebounds in the win over Mount

## Ohio Northern tops Muskingum, Mt Union to clinch No. 2 seed in OAC Tournament

Union. After scoring 11 points against Muskingum, Brand scored double-figures in each of the last 12 games and in 21 of 25 games this season.

- Junior point guard **Emily Culbertson (Mount Vernon)** also scored in double figures in both games last week, including going 10-for-10 from the free throw line against Muskingum. She finished the week with 24 points, nine rebounds, five assists and four steals.

- Senior **Mallory Rentz (Elida)** was one of six Polar Bears in double figures against Muskingum as she scored a career-high 11 points on 2-of-3 from beyond the arc.

- Fellow senior **Jenny Markle (Copley)** made six of her nine 3-point attempts for the week and finished with 24 points. She scored 18 points and dished out three assists in against Muskingum. Markle is shooting 55.9 percent (66-of-118) from beyond the arc this season.

- Senior **Megan Cevasco (Fairlawn/Copley)** scored 21 points and shot 81.8 percent (9-of-11) from the floor on the week. She also grabbed six rebounds and had four assists.

- The Ohio Northern men's indoor track and field team (43-4 overall) won Friday Night Series Meet No. 4 at the ONU Sports Center. The Polar Bears scored 248 points to secure their fifth victory of the season.
- Freshman **Jacob Fox (Rockford/Parkway)** ran a season-best time of 7.63 to win the hurdles and provisionally-qualify for the NCAA III Championships to be hosted by ONU on March 14-15.
- Senior **Ryan Roberston (Pickerington/Central)** and junior **Justin Linzy (Toledo/Woodward)** finished 1-2 in the long jump with leaps of 21-11 and 20-07, respectively.
- The pair also teamed with freshmen **Ryan Fleming (Maitland, Fla./Lyman)** and **Julian Horn (Dewitt, Mich.)** to win the 4x200 relay in a season-best 1:30.93. Horn also won the 55-meter dash in 6.68, while Flemming placed third in 6.75.
- Freshman **Jeff Messmer (Canal Winchester)** added another victory in the sprints, winning the 200-meter dash in 23.09.
- Also recording a victory was sophomore **Joe Amstutz (Bluffton)** running a time of 36.30 to win the 300-meter dash. Freshman **Evan Heyman (Norwalk/Monroeville)** finished right behind Amstutz, placing second

in 36.92. The sophomore also placed second in the 400-meter dash with a time of 51.21, while freshman **Garrett Brown (Atwater/CVCA)** placed third in the 400 in 52.58.

- In the 500-meter run, freshman **Shane Huntley (Sandusky/Perkins)** placed second in 1:09.83, while junior **Jeff Otte (Marion Stein/Marion Local)** placed fourth in 1:11.19.

- Sophomore **Brandon Pritchard (Zanesville/Maysville)** and **Timothy Yeh (Nisswa, Minn./Brainerd)** tied for second in the triple jump with leaps of 37-07.75.

- Leading ONU in the distance events, junior **Steve Darmon (Brimfield/Field)** ran a time of 2:37.23 to win the 1,000-meter run.

- Senior **Tyson Snider (Wauseon/Pettisville)** was runner-up in the 3,000-meter run in a time of 9:22.21.

- Sophomore **Alan Bowsher (Bowling Green)** ran a time of 4:29.55 to place third in the mile.

- Rounding out the distance events was a 1-2 finish in the 5,000-meter run by sophomore **Ben McPheron (Kenton)** and freshman **Jacob Schoenlein's (Lancaster/Amanda Clearcreek)**.

- McPheron finished in 16:13.17, while Schoenlein ran a time of 16:19.36.

### Men's Swimming & Diving

**Record:** 5-4 Overall, 3-1 OAC (1st) - OAC Champions, OAC Regular Season Tri-Champions

**Notes:**

- The Ohio Northern men's swimming and diving team (5-4 overall, 3-1 OAC) won its fourth consecutive OAC Championships title, winning the 2008 OAC Championships Feb. 14-16 at the University of Akron's Ocasek Natatorium.

- Junior **George Chesney (North Olmsted)** and freshman **Michael Schultz (New Berlin, Wis./Martin Luther)** will now wait until the NCAA Division III Championships field is released on March 7 to see who if either man will compete March 20-22 at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio.

- Both men are strong contenders to make the NCAA Championships field.

- Chesney won the OAC title in the 3-meter diving competition with 474.05 points and was second in the 1-meter diving with 448.10 points.

### Chesney, Schultz await fate for spot in NCAA Swimming & Diving Championships

- Chesney surpassed the NCAA "B" cut in both events.

- Schultz was named the OAC Men's Swimmer of the Year. He won six events at the OAC Championships, including the 1650 free (16:00.82), the 500 free (4:36.38) and the 100 fly (52.36), and was part of ONU's winning 400 free (3:12.54), 800 free (7:13.39), and 400 medley relay (3:34.97) teams.

- Schultz shattered a 24-year old OAC record, broke his own ONU record and bettered the NCAA "B" cut in the 1650-yard free, winning the event in 16:00.82. He topped the previous mark of 16:23.06 set in 1984 by Andy Regrut of Kenyon.

- He also broke the Ocasek Natatorium record in the 1,000 free with a 9:39.25 clocking at the 1,000-yard mark of his 1650 swim. The previous mark of 9:39.33 was set in 2001 by Tom Rushton of Kenyon.

- Schultz also set the OAC record and surpassed the NCAA "B" cut in the 500 free.
