



## Courtesy Vans

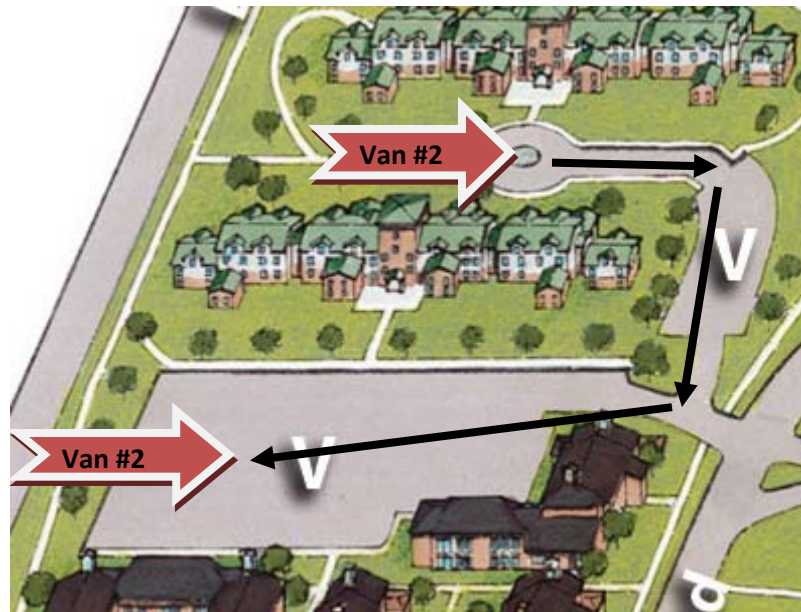
Winter weather in West Central Ohio can be challenging. Members of the University community are asked to pay attention to weather forecasts and take the proper precautions. It is the expectation that most students, faculty and staff will walk to and from classes and campus meetings and will therefore dress warmly and limit their exposure to the elements when conditions are extreme. When wind chill conditions reach 20 degrees below zero or lower, members of the administrative staff will operate a courtesy van service on a limited basis to assist those who are unable to walk to class.

Vans will run from 7:30 a.m. through Noon on those days with extreme temperatures. Pick up locations will be:

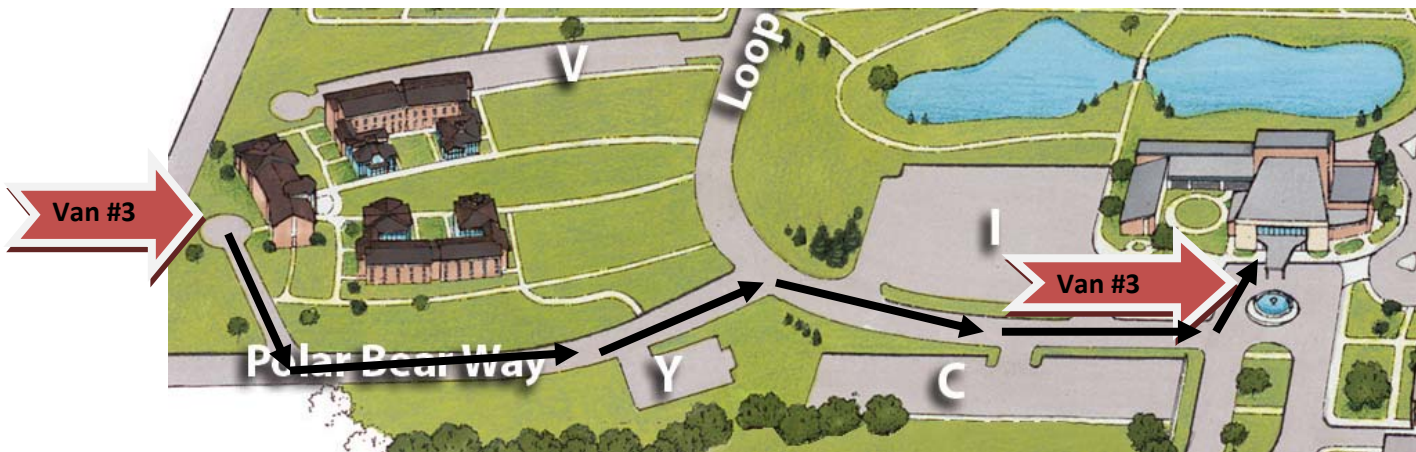
- **Van 1:** Between the Sigma Pi House and Northern House; and the sidewalk to the West of University Terrace between the parking lot and the building



- **Van #2:** The Circle between Stadium View East and West; and the Northern Commons parking lot.



- **Van #3:** The turnaround behind the Affinity Commons Building; and the Freed Center Circle.



- All vans will make stops at the following additional spots: The stop sign on Gilbert Street at the intersection of Dicke, Hill Lot, the Law Building and the Art Building; the stop sign behind Heterick Library; behind Meyer Hall; and behind King-Horn.

When available, a campus mini-bus will do continuous loops making stops at all pick up and drop off locations. Pick ups will begin at 7:30 a.m. and will continue approximately every 10 – 15 minutes until noon. Anyone needing to use the courtesy van service should allow a 30 minute window prior to the time of their class to give themselves the best chance for arriving on time.
