

## Frequently asked questions:

My car that has a permit needs to be serviced. What do I need to do to park my parent's vehicle on campus?

Temporary parking permits are available at no cost if you already purchased a permit. Stop in security with the year, make, model and plate of the temporary vehicle.

I live in an apartment in Ada, am I a commuter?

Yes, you would be a commuter. Anyone not living on campus is defined as a commuter.

I will have a car on campus for a couple of days. Do I have to buy a permit for the whole year?

No you do not have to purchase a permit for the whole year (\$45). Temporary permits are available for \$1 a day. A permit for one quarter is \$30.

At the beginning of the year I lived on campus, now I live off campus. Do I have to pay for another permit?

If you move anytime during the year, on campus, off campus, or across campus stop in Security and update your information. Permits (depending on availability) can be exchanged at no cost.

I am going to have surgery and will be on crutches can I park in Handicap parking?

You can only park in Handicap parking if you have a state issued placard. Speak with your doctor, temporary handicap placards are available through BMV.

My friend (non ONU student) is visiting me, where can they park?

Guests may park in visitor parking to include McIntosh Lot (D) and Freed Lot (I)(no overnight parking).
