

Winter 2008-09 Greek Report Executive Summary

Scholarship

- The **All Greek GPA** is 3.16, equal to that of the All Undergraduate GPA. In addition, the **Greek Women's GPA was higher than the All Women's GPA**, 3.29 and 3.27 respectively.
- **186 members of the Greek community**, or 35.09%, were on the Deans' List this quarter. Of this number, **67 students**, or 36.02%, had a 4.0 GPA.
- **41.47% of Greek women** were on the Deans' List for Winter 2008-09! 32% of these women had a 4.0 GPA! **26.84% of Greek men** were on the Deans' List for Winter 2008-09! 44% of these men had a 4.0 GPA!
- Each quarter, the Office of Greek Life allocates \$300 to be divided equally among all chapters who have a chapter GPA at/ above the all men's/women's GPA. Congratulations to the men of Phi Delta Chi and Phi Mu Delta and the women of Kappa Alpha Theta, Delta Zeta, and Zeta Tau Alpha for their academic accomplishments! Each chapter will receive \$60 to be used towards housing improvements.

Recruitment & Retention

- **148 students joined fraternities and sororities this year** (90 joined the 4 sororities and 58 joined the 6 fraternities).
- 80% of the students who joined a Greek organization this year are still actively involved as of the end of Winter Quarter.
- The Greek population at Ohio Northern University is **17% of the campus** (19% of the women and 15% of the men).

Community Service & Philanthropic Efforts

- The Greek community spent a total of **1,277.5 hours** in direct community service. Greeks performed an average of **17.5 hours of direct community service per day** throughout the quarter!
- **\$5,536.22** were raised for philanthropic organizations by the Greek community. An average of **\$75.83 per day were raised** by the Greek community to benefit philanthropic organizations throughout the quarter!

Housing

- Each of the 10 chapters has a housing facility for their members. These houses include those in the Affinity Village, Fraternity Circle, as well as off-campus locations throughout Ada.
- The facilities are checked on a quarterly basis by the Life-Safety Committee of the University. **For the Winter Quarter, each of the houses passed the inspection.**

Advisor Involvement

- **Each Greek chapter has a faculty/staff advisor at ONU** as well as other advisors who are actively involved in the organization of the chapter.
- The Office of Greek Life hosts an advisor meeting on a quarterly basis for updates and discussion.
