- Personal Statement minimum 250-words
- High school teacher/counselor recommendation form (optional for Transfer Students)
- Affidavit of Financial Support and supporting documents.
- Optional: SAT or ACT exam scores

Transfer Students- All of the above, plus the following documents.

- Official transcripts from any postsecondary institutions
- Transcript evaluation from certified transcript evaluator (i.e. World Education Services)

TRANSFER ADMISSION

Students interested in transferring to Ohio Northern University must submit official transcripts from all colleges previously attended as well as a final high school transcript. These documents must be sent directly to Ohio Northern University from your previous college(s)/high school. The application deadline for the College of Pharmacy is February 1 for transfer students.

Meeting ONU's English language requirement

- I. For regular admission to an academic program: TOEFL score of 550 paper-based (pbt), 213 computer-based (cbt), or 79 Internet-based (ibt), or above. IELTS score of 6.0 or above (International English Language Testing System).
- II. For Bridging Program Admission: Degree-seeking students with a TOEFL between 480-545 pbt, 157-210 cbt or 54-77 ibt can apply for admission to ONU and attend up to one academic year in ONU's ESL Bridging Program. Students take regular academic courses with ONU credit while enrolled in ESL.

INSTRUCTIONS For Educational Background Form

- Column 1 — On each line, write the years you attended, each school listed.
- Column 2 — Write your age. If you were 6 years old when you attended school for the first time, write 6 on the first line. Continue by writing your correct age for each grade you attended.
