Football

Record: 2-2 Overall, 1-2 OAC (16th)

Notes:

- The No. 16-ranked Ohio Northern football team (2-2, 1-2 OAC) knocked off Muskingum in a 37-34 thriller Sat. night in new Concord.
- Juniors **Kyle Simmons (Orrville)** and **Brent Donley (West Bloomfield, Mich.)** each had out-standing games on offense to lead ONU.

- Donley ran 28 times for 102 yards and two TDs and caught four passes for 61 yards and another score.

- Simmons carried the ball 14 times for a career-high 93 yards and TD runs of 1 and 20 yards and completed 14 of 22 passes for 240 yards and a TD to Donley.

- But it was the Polar Bear defense that made the big plays down the stretch that were key in the ONU victory.

- First, with Northern clinging to a 37-34 lead with 3:32 left in the game and the Muskies in possession at the ONU 20-yard line, junior **J.J. Mihoci (Jefferson)** intercepted a pass at the ONU 5-yard line to thwart the scoring opportunity.

- After two Donley plunges netted six yards, Simmons hit a huge 46-yard bomb to junior **Ryan Fleming (Longwood, Fla./Lyman)**, their second 40-plus yard pass of the night, to put the ball on the MU 42-yard line with less than two

minutes on the clock.

- After a punt, the ONU defense came up big again, as junior **David Rush (Ada)** sacked MU for a 5-yard loss back to the 8-yard line on first down. Two incompletions later, senior **Josh Horn (Franklin)** ended the contest with another sack of Burns on the night on a 4th and 15 play.

- Horn finished the game with a career-high 14 tackles and tied his career highs with 3.0 sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss.

- The Polar Bear offense was solid all night, finishing the game with 450 yards of total offense, with 210 coming on the ground and 240 through the air. The Polar Bear defense registered a season-high 8 QB sacks.

- Extra points were a key part of the game as each team scored five touchdowns in the contest.

- Muskingum missed a PAT on its first score and twice Simmons bobbled a snap on a Northern PAT attempts and converted them into 2-point conversion passes to account for the 3-point difference in scoring in the contest.

- Donley's 100-yard rushing effort was the second of the season and the sixth of his career. Fleming also had a career day, catching three passes for a career-high 107 yards.

- ONU will return to action Sat. when they play host to Heidelberg at 1:30 pm as part of ONU's Homecoming Weekend festivities.

- Sophomore **Dan Smith (Avon)** finished 11th in a time of 27:54.6.

- Senior **Brent Hiser (Gibsonburg)** and sophomore **Nick Baker (Loveland)** rounded out Northern's scoring.

- Hiser finished 13th in a time of 27:59.2, while Baker finished 35th in a time of 28:35.2
