#1 Catchers Clinic

Two instructional hours of drill, demonstration, and lecture including: framing, blocking, throwing, stance and footwork.

#2 Hitters Clinic

Monday, July 27, 2009 10:00 a.m. - Noon

Thursday, July 30, 2009 10:00 a.m. - Noon
Two instructional hours of drill, demonstration, and lecture including: hitting, bunting, situational hitting, and hitting fundamentals.

#3 Pitchers Clinic

Monday, July 27, 2009 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.
Wednesday, July 29, 2009 3:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.
Two instructional hours of drill, demonstration, and lecture on pitching techniques and fielding responsibilities. Campers work on mechanics, pick-off moves, covering first base, pitch selection, fielding, and arm care.

#4 Infielder/Outfielder Clinic

Tuesday, July 28, 2009 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.
Two instructional hours of infield and outfield techniques. All campers will be worked at all positions. Versatility is an essential part of becoming a complete baseball player.

#5 High School Prospect Clinic

Sunday, October 18, 2009 2:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.
This prospect clinic is for student-athletes grades 10-12 who are seriously considering college baseball. You will go through a pro-style showcase workout and you will receive individual instruction in these areas: Pitching, Catching, Hitting, Infield/Outfield and Base-running.

About the Coaches

Justin Bergman

Justin Bergman is in his fifth season as head baseball coach at Ohio Northern University. Bergman came to Ohio Northern after a one-year stint as assistant coach at his alma mater, Franklin (Ind.) College. He also served as a graduate assistant at Manchester (Ind.) from 2002-04, where he earned his master's degree in contemporary leadership. A 2001 graduate of Franklin with a degree in secondary education, Bergman was a four-year starter in left field for the Grizzlies. In his four years as a Grizzly, he helped Franklin become a strong contender for the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference title under head coach Lance Marshall. The 2001 Franklin team finished second place overall in league play. While at Manchester, the baseball program won 97 games. The 2002 team won the conference tournament and went on to play at the NCAA Mid-East Regional tournament. In 2004, Manchester won the league's regular season title and the conference tournament championship, going on to win the Mid-East Regional tournament and advancing to the NCAA Division III World Series in Appleton, Wisconsin. In the summer of 2001, Bergman served as head coach for the Indiana Dox Connie Mack summer baseball team. The Dox advanced to the Connie Mack World Series in Welland, Canada. Bergman is from Milroy, Indiana, and is a graduate of Rushville Consolidated High School. He resides in Ada, with his wife Amber.

Shaun Swearingen

Shaun Swearingen enters his second season as the assistant coach for the Ohio Northern Baseball Program. Swearingen comes to ONU after graduating from the College of Wooster this past Spring ('07). During his four years at the Wooster, Swearingen played both football and baseball for the Fighting Scots. He tallied a total of four conference championships in his college career, one in football and three in baseball. He made All-Conference honors as a Wide Receiver his junior year and compiled a total record of 32-10 during his four year football career. In baseball, Shaun was a four-year starter in the outfield under Head Coach Tim Pettorini. During his four year stint he helped the Scots compile a record of 156-35. The highlight of his career came in the 2005 season when Wooster finished third in the NCAA Division III College World Series. He earned Second Team All NCAC honors as a sophomore and garnered First Team Honors as a junior and senior. Also as a junior, he was named First Team All-District, First Team All-Region, and was eligible to be an All-American Honoree.
