Housing Information and Checklist

The housing facilities we will be staying in include:

- * Air conditioning
- * Kitchen and dining area
- * Full bath
- * On-site laundry facilities
- * Living room
- * If medication needs to be dispensed, the camp director will make appropriate arrangements.
- * Convenient parking (Use of personal vehicle is not permitted during camp, ONLY for arrival and departure.)

You should plan to bring the following:

- Spending money for entertainment and personal use
- Casual summer clothes (shorts, t-shirts, sandals, etc.) We recommend dressing in layers as classroom temperatures range from very warm to very cold.
- Workout/exercise clothing (sweats, shorts, sneakers, etc.)
- Swimsuits and beach towels (depending on weather)
- Shower shoes
- Hiking boots/shoes
- Lightweight jacket or sweatshirt/Poncho
- Blanket, slippers (room can get chilly at night)
- Toiletries (shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, razors, soap, deodorant, hair dryer, etc.)
- Flashlight

You *may also* want to bring the following:

- Portable radio
- Sports equipment (racquetball and/or tennis racquets, basketball, volleyball, etc.)
- Food/snacks
- Camera (inexpensive or disposable)

The individual dorm rooms are locked, but you may bring **AT YOUR OWN RISK**, the following:

- ≈ Cell phones, pagers, or other similar devices (NOTE: The Director reserves the right to collect cell phones if students do not exhibit proper telephone use and etiquette.)
- ≈ Phones will be stored in a safe area and returned to students upon departure.
- ≈ Laptop computer, camcorders, digital cameras and ipods
- ≈ Expensive jewelry, over \$100 in cash, etc.
